Toyota Funds Intelligent Vehicle Research


Toyota recently funded electrical engineering research at UC San Diego aimed at developing a computational prediction model for transferring control back and forth between car and driver. The research is led by Jacobs School electrical engineering professor Mohan Trivedi, whose teams of researchers have been working with Toyota and other carmakers for years to advance intelligent vehicle technologies. This most recent funding comes from Toyota's Collaborative Safety Research Center (CSRC). Intelligent vehicle research in the Trivedi lab often includes a particular focus on humans.
